

Oxy released 5 bbls of oil, and 20 bbls of water due to a line leak on the 3 inch poly produced water transfer line. The battery is located in Section 35, Township 21 South, Range 31 East of Eddy County. Oxy will do some initial remediation, a C-141 to follow. BBC International will delineate at a later date.
