Reference is made to your application received on March 28, 2013.

You have requested approval of an unorthodox oil well location for the well described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by Order No. R-12984 [September 3, 2008] which provides for 320-acre units with wells located at least 660 feet from the outer boundary of a spacing unit, and Rule 15.16.14.B(2) [19.15.16.14.B(2) NMAC] concerning directional wells in designated project areas. The location is unorthodox because the terminus is closer than 660 feet from the outer boundary of the spacing unit and corresponding project area.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 [19.15.15.13 NMAC] and 4.12.A(2) [19.15.4.12.A(2) NMAC].

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It is our understanding that you are seeking this location approval based on a determination by District III that this well is in the Basin-Mancos Gas Pool.
