

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*
The discharge hose from a water transfer pump ruptured, releasing produced water and oil.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
An approximate area of 36' X 100' (most of release occurred inside of the unlined bermed battery. Some of the water/oil escaped out of the berm to the south of the tanks). A vacuum truck was called to recover fluids, all wells to battery were shut in, tank valves were shut, and hose was repaired. A crew was called to do initial clean-up of the area, and all excavated soils will be disposed of at an approved NMOCD facility. Vertical and horizontal delineation samples will be taken and sent to a NMOCD approved facility. Depth to Ground Water: >100' (approximately 150', Section 11, T22S-R31E, per Trend Map), Wellhead Protection Area: No, Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000', SITE RANKING IS 0.
