Mr. Hansen:

Rice Operating Company (ROC) is the service provider (agent) for the EME Saltwater Disposal (SWD) System and has no ownership of any portion of the pipeline, well, or facility. The System is owned by a consortium of oil producers, System Parties, who provide all operating capital on a percentage ownership/usage basis.

Background

In 2001, ROC initiated work on the former P-36-2 junction box. The site is located in UL/P, Sec. 36, T19S, R36E. NM OSE records indicate that groundwater would likely be encountered at a depth of approximately 50 +/- feet. The site was delineated using a backhoe to collect soil samples at regular intervals, creating a 12x10x15 ft deep excavation. Each sample was field titrated for chlorides, resulting in slightly elevated chloride concentrations. Representative samples were collected from the excavation bottom and sent to a commercial laboratory for analysis. The bottom composite sample resulted in a chloride concentration of 1,070 mg/kg and concentrations of gasoline range organics (GRO) and diesel range organics (DRO) below detectable limits. The sample was also analyzed for BTEX, resulting in a concentration below detectable limits for benzene and ethyl benzene, 0.016 mg/kg for toluene and 0.038 mg/kg for total xylenes. A total for 32 cubic yards of excavated soil was properly disposed of at a NMOCD facility. A compacted clay liner was installed and the excavation was backfilled with clean imported soil and a new, watertight junction was installed at the site.

To further investigate the depth of chloride presence, a soil bore was initiated on May 2, 2001. The boring was advanced to a total depth of 20 ft with soil samples collected at

regular intervals, resulting in a chloride concentration that decreased with depth. The 20 ft sample was sent to a commercial laboratory for analysis, resulting in a chloride concentration of 186 mg/kg, a GRO concentration below detectable limits, and a DRO concentration of 12.6. The sample was also analyzed for BTEX, resulting in concentrations below detectable limits throughout.

Since the site is located next to a lease road, seeding is not required. A new, watertight junction was installed at the site.

The junction box site location map, final report, laboratory analysis, soil bore log, disposal manifest and current photodocumentation are attached.

Recommendations

Site investigation demonstrates that residual chloride and hydrocarbons in the vadose zone will not with reasonable probability contaminate groundwater in excess of NMOCD standards. This site meets the requirements of the NMOCD-approved Revised Junction Box Upgrade Work Plan (July 16, 2003). As such, ROC request termination of the regulatory file, or similar closure status.






Site Location Map




finding chlorides above acceptable levels. A soil boring was completed and demonstrated impact stopped before reaching groundwater. Chlorides declined from 19,100 ppm at 5' bgs to 186 ppm at 20' bgs with no indications of TPH. The high impact soil was removed to a permitted facility and fresh soil was blended to use for backfill. A compacted clay barrier and water tight junction box was installed and backfilled. No wall composite was sent to the lab.



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
