Reference is made to your application received on April 10, 2013.

You have requested to recomplete an existing well at an unorthodox well location described above, in the referenced pools. The downhole commingling of the pools has been approved by the district III under DHC-3758-AZ.

The location is governed by Order No. R-1882, as amended, for the Totah-Gallup pool which provides for 80-acre units with wells located within 150 feet of the center of either quarter-quarter section in the 80-acre unit. This location is also governed by Order No. R-10987-B, as amended, for the Basin Dakota pool with setback requirements for wells of 660 feet from any outer boundary of the quarter section on which the well is located and not closer than 10 feet

to any quarter-quarter section line or subdivision interior boundary. The location of the existing well is greater than 150 feet from the center of Unit P (SE/4 SE/4).

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 [19.15.15.13 NMAC] and 4.12.A(2) [19.15.4.12.A(2) NMAC].

It is our understanding that you are seeking this location approval in order to minimize surface impacts, protect correlative rights, and prevent waste.

It is also understood that you have given due notice of this application to all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in Rule 4.12.A(2), in all adjoining units towards which the proposed location encroaches.

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Division Rule 15.13.B, the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.

This approval is subject to your being in compliance with all other applicable Division rules, including, but not limited to Division Rule 5.9 [19.15.15.9 NMAC].

Jurisdiction of this case is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
