

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* The 3" water dump line from the heater-treater to the water tank developed a leak due to internal corrosion. A repair clamp was placed on the affected area of the pipe.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\* The spill affected approximately 5800 sq. ft. of caliche well pad and tank battery pad. The saturated soil was scraped up and stockpiled on-site, pending final disposition. Following initial response activities, the release was remediated as per NMOCD recommended guidelines for spills and releases. Please reference the attached *Remediation Summary & Risk-Based Site Closure Request* for remediation details.
