Ike,

I have received your sampling notification. This location has arch survey stipulations and to my knowledge we have not yet received an arch survey of the area from the operator. Usually, when such surveys are received they are forwarded to me along with any special stipulations the archeologists deem necessary to protect cultural resource concerns.

Has an arch survey been completed? Will you be walking the site and hand sampling, or will you be using heavy equipment? Usually sampling and cleanup operations are delayed until the arch clearances and special stipulations are determined, particularly in cases that require an archeological monitor to be present during all activities. Hand sampling impacts are minimal, compared to core drilling, of course, but there is still the potential for digging into cultural resources. I do not know whether or not the staff archeologists would permit hand sampling prior to receiving the requested arch survey of the spill area. The arch staff is gone for the day, and pickings may be quite slim for tomorrow due to the holidays.

If an arch survey has been completed and delivered to the BLM, contact either Bruce Boeke, 575-234-5917, or George McDonnell, 575-234-2228, for approval to go ahead and sample the location, complying with any special stipulations that they may require to do so. If the arch survey has not been completed, you will still need to contact them to proceed with sampling of the site prior to completion of a survey. I will put a copy of this email along with your cell phone number on both of their desks along with the spill map and legals of the location in question.

I have called and left a message on your cell phone to that effect as well.
