Approximately 4000 sq. ft. of pasture land was misted with oil and water from the broken gauge. The site was excavated and soil samples were collected from backhoe trenches. The samples were sent to a commercial lab for analyses. The excavation was installed with a 20 mil reinforced plastic liner at 3 ft. and padded with imported sand. The excavation was capped with caliche, and the site was leveled and dressed.
