COG would like to submit the enclosed documents for closure of the Wildcap State #4H release that was reported on the C-141 Initial submitted April 22, 2014.



Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*
This was an act of vandalism, the seal had been cut off the valve was lying on the ground. Closed valve and replaced seal.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
Initially 125bbls of oil were released. We were able to recover 40bbls of oil with a vacuum truck. All free fluids have been recovered. Concho will have the spill site sampled to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.

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
