the containment. A vacuum truck was dispatched to pick up any free standing liquids. There were approximately 40 bbls recovered. An Emergency Response Team arrived at the release area and began continuous abatement of the impacted area. Visibly stained soil was excavated and hauled		
away for disposal at a state approved facility.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Approximately 2,300 square feet of surface area was impacted by the release. Soil samples will not be collected from release area due to finding a poly liner while removing contaminated soil. All contaminated soil has been removed and hauled for disposal and the tank battery liner has been covered with clean caliche.
