Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* Lime Rock Resources was completing the well. When personnel arrived on location this morning, a frac tank containing hydrochloric acid was found to be leaking. A vac truck was immediately called to the location and the hydrochloride acid standing on location was recovered. The impacted area was then covered using soda ash.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The affected area remained on the location and did not impact adjacent pasture lands. Talon/LPE was called to remediate this incident. The impacted area will be scraped approximately 0.25-feet deep and disposed of at a NMOCD approved facility. The excavated area will be subsequently tested for pH. Upon acceptable results, the NMOCD and BLM will be petitioned for approval to backfill and reconstruct the location.
