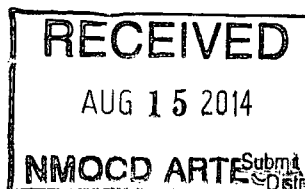

Concho will have the spill site sampled to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOC for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
