If a Watercourse was Impacted, Describe Fully.*

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* A water transfer line from the Mad Dog 15 Federal Com No. 1 was found to be leaking. Approximately 80 barrels of produced water was released off the east side of Adobe Road into the drainage ditch. The affected area measured approximately 3-4 feet wide by 900-feet long. No fluids were recovered. Talon/LPE was contracted to remediate this release.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The impacted area in the drainage ditch was excavated to and depth of 3-feet deep. All of the contaminated soil was transported to Lea Land, LLC for disposal. Upon NMOCD approval of the confirmation samples the excavation was backfilled with new topsoil. The area was contoured to match the surrounding terrain. No further action is required.
