This is to inform you that Oxy Permian Primary NM South had a leak at the Sterling Silver 33 Federal #1H on September 18, 2014. Oxy spilled 120 bbls oil due to the failure of a head switch on a tank at the well. The preliminary report shows the leak measuring approximately 30' x 25' with all of the leak staying on location. A vacuum truck recovered 100 bbls of oil. The release is located in U/L P, Section 33, T23S, R31E of Eddy County, NM. BBC International will remediate the location at a later date and an initial C-141 will follow. Driving directions: From Jal, go West on NM128 to between mile marker 13 and mile marker 14, turn South and go 2 miles, turn left and go 1 mile, turn South and go 0.25 mile, turn left and go 0.25 mile, turn right and dead end on location..
