The commingled gas production shall be measured and sold at the L.C. Kelly Well No. 16 (CTB) located in Unit C, Section 5, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, San Juan County, NMPM, New Mexico.

Gas production from for the L.C. Kelly Well No. 16 shall be calculated by subtracting the volume for the L.C. Kelly Well No. 1E. The L.C. Kelly Well No. 1E shall be equipped with an allocation meter. The allocation meter shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

The operator shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Aztec District Office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.
