Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken: A flow line from the PLU-205 pumping well developed a leak at the PLU-158 Battery, a repair clamp was installed on the line.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Approximately 300 sq. ft. of pasture land on the north side of the battery pad, all of the free oil was picked up with a vacuum truck. A remediation plan will be developed in accordance with the NMOCD and BLM remediation guidelines.

Remediation activities conducted at the Poker Lake Unit Well #205 at the PLU #158 Battery met the objectives set forth during the September 6, 2012, meeting between BOPCO and NMOCD Representatives. Soil samples collected from the floor and sidewalls of the excavation were analyzed by an NMOCD-approved laboratory. On September 7, 2012, an NMOCD-approved polyurethane liner was installed in the floor of the excavation. Between September 7 and September 11, 2012, approximately 240 cy of impacted soil was excavated and transported to an NMOCD-approved disposal facility. Prior to backfilling, the final dimensions of the excavation were approximately 25' in width, 45' in length and 2' in depth.
