
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

This release was caused by corrosion in a steel flowline. The leak was isolated and vacuum trucks were dispatched to recover any standing fluid. All fluid was disposed of at an NMOCD approved facility.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The impacted area is located in the pasture. And is approximately 200' x 17' in size. Concho will have the spill site sampled to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
