On behalf of Enterprise Products Operating Company Inc. (Enterprise), Kleinfelder, Inc. (Kleinfelder) is submitting this proof of public notice in support of the hydrostatic discharge permit for the B-6 Lateral pipeline.

The Notice of Intent (NOI) to discharge hydrostatic test water from the B-6 Lateral and application to discharge was deemed administratively complete by the New Mexico Energy, Minerals, and Natural Resources Department Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) on November 7, 2013.

Enterprise is planning to conduct hydrostatic testing on a new 12-inch inner-diameter line named B-6 Replacement Lateral in Eddy County, New Mexico. Actual placement of water into the pipeline is scheduled to start on or about May 15, 2014. Approximately 58,397 feet of piping will be tested.

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission Regulations (20.6.2 NMAC), the following discharge permit application(s) has been submitted to the Director of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("OCD"), 1220 S. Saint Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505, Telephone (505) 476-3440:

(HIP-129) Enterprise Products Operating, LLC (Enterprise), 1031 Andrews Highway, Suite 320, Midland, Texas 79701, has submitted an application for an Individual Hydrostatic Test Discharge Permit to the New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department, Oil Conservation Division to hydrostatic test approximately 11.06 miles (58,397) feet of a new 12.25-inch inner diameter natural gas transmission pipeline, approximately 15 miles northwest of Carlsbad, New Mexico. Enterprise will obtain water for the hydrostatic test from the City of Carlsbad. Approximately 360,000 gallons of wastewater will be generated from the hydrostatic test, and tested prior to discharge or disposal. The discharge site is on private property near the northwestern end of the B-6 Lateral located in the SW/4 of the NW/4, Section 23, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. To reach the discharge location from Carlsbad, New Mexico: From the intersection of NM-524 W (W. Lea St.) and US-285 (S. Canal), head west on NM-524W (W. Lea St.) for approximately 2.4 miles; Take a slight right (northwest) onto nm-524 W (S. Happy Valley Rd.) and continue for 6.1 miles; Turn northwest onto US-285 (Seven Rivers Hwy) and continue 9.3 miles; Turn west onto White Pine Rd. and continue 1.9 miles; Turn south onto County Road 28A (Salt Brush Rd.) and continue 41.7 miles; Turn north onto the pipeline right-of-way and continue for 0.4 miles; the discharge area will be on the right side of the road. Due to the pipeline being new construction and the source water to be used during the testing, the discharge water is expected to meet Water Quality Control Commission (WQCC) water quality standards. If WQCC water quality standards are not met the test wastewater will be hauled to an approved disposal facility. The shallowest groundwater most likely to be affected by an accidental discharge is at a depth of approximately 32 feet below ground surface with a total dissolved solids concentration of approximately 1,300 mg/l. The discharge plan consists of a description of the method and location for collection, testing and retention of fluids and solids, how products and wastes will be properly handled, stored, and disposed of, including how spills, leaks, and other accidental discharges to the surface will be managed in order to protect fresh water.

OCD has determined that the application is administratively complete and has prepared a draft permit. OCD will accept comments and statements of interest regarding this application and will create a facility-specific mailing list for persons who wish to receive future notices. Persons interested in obtaining further information, submitting comments or requesting to be on a facility-specific mailing list for future notices may contact the Environmental Bureau Chief of the Oil Conservation Division at the address given above. The administrative completeness determination and draft permit may be viewed at the above address between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, or may also be viewed at the OCD web site http://www.emnrd.state.nm.us/OCD/env-draftpublicetc.html. Persons interested in obtaining a copy of the application and draft permit may contact the OCD at the address given above. Prior to ruling on any proposed discharge permit or major modification, the Director shall allow a period of at least thirty (30) days after the date of publication of this notice, during which interested persons may submit comments or request that OCD hold a public hearing. Requests for a public hearing shall set forth the reasons why a hearing should be held. A hearing will be held if the Director determines that there is significant public interest.

If no public hearing is held, the Director will approve or disapprove the proposed permit based on information available, including all comments received. If a public hearing is held, the Director will approve or disapprove the proposed permit

based on information in the permit application and information submitted at the hearing.

The Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has received Enterprise Products Operating LLC's (Enterprise) revised notice of intent, dated November 4, 2013 and received November 6, 2013, for authorization to discharge approximately 360,000 gallons of wastewater generated from a hydrostatic test of approximately 11.06 miles (58,397) feet of a new 12.25-inch inner diameter natural gas transmission pipeline, approximately 15 miles northwest of Carlsbad, New Mexico. The proposed discharge/collection/retention location on private property near the northwestern end of the B-6 Lateral located in the SW/4 of the NW/4, Section 23, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. OCD acknowledges the receipt of the filing fee (\$100.00) and the permit fee (\$600.00) for the permit from a submittal dated November 4, 2013.

Based on the information provided in the request, the hydrostatic test water discharge is hereby approved with the following understandings and conditions:

- 1. Enterprise will be testing approximately 11.06 miles (58,397) feet of a new 12.25-inch inner diameter natural gas transmission pipeline, approximately 15 miles northwest of Carlsbad, New Mexico:
- 2. Enterprise will acquire the hydrostatic test water from the City of Carlsbad, New Mexico;
- 3. Enterprise will generate approximately 360,000 gallons of hydrostatic test wastewater from the test event. The hydrostatic wastewater will remain in the pipeline while being sampled and awaiting test results from a certified laboratory;
- 4. Enterprise shall analyze all samples of wastewater generated from the hydrostatic test to demonstrate the results do not exceed the standards as set forth in Subsections A, B, and C of

the 20.6.2.3103 NMAC, except for Combined Radium 226 & Radium 228 due to pre-test results;

- 5. Enterprise shall submit the test results via email or fax to the OCD for review and subsequent approval or disapproval for the test wastewater to be discharged;
- 6. If the final discharge of the wastewater is approved by the OCD, Enterprise will discharge the wastewater into a dewatering structure, constructed of non-woven geotextile and hay bales, to control erosion and contain the discharge on private property near the northwestern end of the B-6 Lateral located in the SW/4 of the NW/4, Section 23, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico;
- 7. If final discharge of the wastewater is approved, no hydrostatic wastewater generated will be discharged to groundwater or be allowed to exit the easement right-of-way;
- 8. If final discharge of the wastewater is approved, no discharge shall occur:
 - a. where ground water is less than 10 feet below ground surface.
 - b. within 200 feet of a watercourse, lakebed, sinkhole or playa lake;
 - c. within an existing wellhead protection area;
 - d. within, or within 500 feet of a wetland; or
 - e. within 500 feet from the nearest permanent residence, school, hospital, institution or church;
- 9. If the final discharge of the wastewater is not approved by the OCD, Enterprise will transfer the wastewater, via a system of flexible hoses and pump, from the pipeline into water trucks and hauled by an OCD approved C-133 water hauler to Mesquite SWD, Inc.'s Class II injection well (API 30-015-23728/Order SWD 247-A) for injection and disposal;
- 10. Enterprise will have personnel on-site to oversee and control the transfer and utilize collection pans placed below the collection points to prevent an unauthorized release;
- 11. Enterprise will not be analyzing the hydrostatic test wastewater prior to disposal because of the following: the wastewater has been demonstrated to be RCRA exempt waste and the proposal is to transfer the wastewater to Mesquite SWD, Inc.'s Class II injection well for injection and disposal;
- 12. Enterprise will ensure the transfer the hydrostatic test wastewater via an OCD approved C-133 water hauler to Mesquite SWD, Inc.'s Class II injection well (API 30-015-23728/Order SWD 247-A) for injection and disposal;
- 13. Enterprise shall remove all hydrostatic test wastewater from the collection/retention location within ten (10) calendar days of the completion of the hydrostatic test;
- 14. Enterprise shall restore any surface area impacted or disturb from the approved activities;
- 15. Enterprise shall implement best management practices to prevent unauthorized releases during the transfer/collection activities;

- 16. Enterprise shall ensure that the discharge/transfer/collection activities do not cause any fresh water supplies to be degraded or to exceed standards as set forth in Subsections A, B, and C of the 20.6.2.3103 NMAC (the New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission Regulations);
- 17. Enterprise must properly notify the landowner(s) of the proposed discharge/collection location of the approved activities prior to the hydrostatic test event; and
- 18. Enterprise shall report all unauthorized discharges, spills, leaks and releases of hydrostatic test water and conduct corrective action pursuant to OCD Rule 29 (19.15.29 NMAC).

It is understood that the hydrostatic test discharge will begin approximately December 30, 2013. This permit will expire within 120 calendar days of its issue date. This permit may be revoked or suspended for violation of any applicable provisions and/or conditions.

Please be advised that approval of this request does not relieve Enterprise of liability should operations result in pollution of surface water, ground water or the environment. Nor does approval relieve Enterprise of its responsibility to comply with any other applicable governmental authority's rules and regulations.
