

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Pipeline leak was detected by Gulf Coast Helicopter pilot. The leaking portion was isolated, and pipeline section was blown down to start repair activities. The pipeline segment will be brought back online as soon as the leak is fully repaired.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Approximately 5 bbl of pipeline liquid were released from the leak within the pipeline Right of Way. Operations collected the contaminated soil during excavation of the pipeline. Subsequent cleanup activities are being scheduled and soil sampling will be performed to verify affected area is clean.
