

Dear Mr. Catanach:

EOG Resources, Inc. (OGRID No. 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Neptune 10 State Com #502H Well** to be completed within the Triple X Bone Spring; West (Pool Code 96674) underlying Section 10, Township 24 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. This well will be drilled from a surface location 251 feet from the South line and 1120 feet from the East line of Section 10, Township 24 South, Range 33 East (Unit P). The upper most perforation will be 330 feet from the South line and 1380 feet from the East line of Section 10 (Unit O) and the lower most perforation will be 330 feet from the North line and 1380 feet from the East line of Section 15 (Unit B). Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules which provides for wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit, the completed interval for this well will be unorthodox. Approval of the unorthodox completed interval will allow for efficient well spacing in Section 10, prevent waste of a productive reservoir and improve well performance.

**Exhibit A** is the Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102), which shows that the completed interval of the proposed **Neptune 10 State Com # 502H Well** encroaches on the spacing and proration unit to the Northeast, East and Southeast.

**Exhibit B** is a land plat for Section 10 and the surrounding sections that shows the proposed Neptune 10 State Com # 502H Well in relation to adjoining units and existing wells.



EOG operates the spacing units affected by the encroachment to the Northeast and East, but has provided notice to its partner, Devon Energy Production Company. Murchison Oil & Gas, Inc. is the only party affected by the encroachment to the Southeast. Both parties have been provided a copy of this application and all attachments by certified mail, and have been advised that if they have an objection it must be filed in writing with the division within 20 days from the date the division receives this application. A courtesy copy of this application has been provided to the New Mexico State Land Office.

Your attention to this matter is appreciated.




