isolated, and the gasket was replaced.

The liquid also travelled down a lease road for approximately 360 ft. The entire area of the well pad and battery location was also												
covered with a fine mist of crude oil and produced water; this was approximately 67,500 sq. ft. The pasture land located to the South West of the battery												
was also affected with the fine mist of crude oil and produced water; this area was approximately 33,600 sq. ft. The release was remediated as per NMOCD guidelines.
