Affected area- South/Southeast of the production tanks out in the pasture an estimated 50 feet from well pad. Vacuum truck was used to recover 3 bbls of oil. Contaminated soil will be dug out and hauled off to R360 by Trinity Oilfield Services. Once soil samples are taken and backfill approval is given by the appropriate government agencies, clean backfill will be brought in to replace contaminated soil.
