Re: Application of EOG Resources, Inc. for administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its Streetcar 15 Fed #8H Well to be completed in Section 15, Township 25 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

Dear Mr. Catanach:

EOG Resources, Inc. (OGRID No. 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Streetcar 15 Fed #8H Well** to be completed within the Draper Mill; Bone Spring (Oil) Pool (Pool Code 96392) underlying Section 15, Township 25 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. This well will be drilled from a surface location 250 feet from the South line and 1450 feet from the East line of Section 15, Township 25 South, Range 33 East. The upper most perforation will be 330 feet from the South line and 1389 feet from the East line of Section 15 (Unit O) and the lower most perforation will be 330 feet from the North line and 1389 feet from the East line of Section 15 (Unit B). Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules which provides for wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit, the completed interval for this well will be unorthodox. Approval of the unorthodox completed interval will allow for efficient well spacing in Section 15, prevent waste of a productive reservoir and improve well performance.

Exhibit A is the Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102), which shows that the completed interval of the proposed **Streetcar 15 Fed #8H Well** encroaches on the spacing and proration unit to the Northeast, East and Southeast.

Exhibit B is a land plat for Section 15 and the surrounding sections that shows the proposed **Streetcar 15 Fed #8H Well** in relation to adjoining units and existing wells.



BTA Oil Producers, LLC is the only party affected by the encroachment to the Northeast and Southeast. Enclosed as **Exhibit C** is BTA's waiver of the 20 day notice period and acceptance of the proposed non-standard location. EOG is the sole operator and mineral lessee of the federal lease covering Section 15. Accordingly, there are no affected parties by the encroachment to the East. Nonetheless, a courtesy copy of this application has been provided to the Bureau of Land Management.




