Pursuant to your application received on March 30, 2015, Yates Petroleum Corporation (OGRID 25575) is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from the following pools located in Township 19 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico;

Parkway; Bone Spring	(49622)

and from the following diversely owned wells on federal leases in said Township and Range in Eddy County, New Mexico.

330' FSL & 1980' FEL

Antweil "ANU" Federal Well No. 4H
API No. 30-015-40426
860' FSL & 660' FWL
M-29-19S-30E

The project area for these wells include the W/2 E/2 of Section 19, the S/2 S/2 of Section 29, and the S/2 SW/4 of Section 28, Township 19 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The commingled oil and gas production shall be measured and sold at the Antweil "ANU" Federal Well No. 4H Central Tank Battery (CTB) located in Unit M, Section 29, Township 19 South, Range 30 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Oil and gas production from each of the leases shall be separately metered before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC

The operator shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.

This approval is subject to like approval from the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) before commencement of the commingling operations.
