Devon Energy Production Company, LP (OGRID 6137) is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from the Cotton Draw; Brushy Canyon Pool (13370) from the following leases and wells:

The spacing units for these wells include the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 35, and NE/4 NW/4 of Section 36, Township 24 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Cotton Draw No. 90 central tank battery (CTB), located in Unit D, of Section 36, Township 24 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The oil production shall be based on a combination of well testing and tank gauging method.

The gas production from each well shall be continuously measured with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.

It is our understanding that notice of this application has been provided to all owners of interest in the subject wells. No objection has been received by the Division during the objection period.

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This approval is subject to like approval from the Bureau of Land Management and the New Mexico State Land Office before commencing commingling operations.
