Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

A produced water flow line ruptured. Pumps were turned off and valves were shut. Vacuum truck(s) and roustabout crews were called.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

An approximate pooling area with an area of 0.2152 acres was affected and an area of 0.3168 acres (to the east of the pooling area) was affected by overspray. The majority of the release puddled in a low spot near valves of the flow line. Vacuum trucks were called to recover the spill. The pooling area has been initially scraped 6"-1". Excavated soils are being hauled to a NMOCD approved facility. The overspray area was sprayed with a microblaze solution. Vertical and horizontal delineation samples will be taken and analysis ran for TPH & BTEX (chlorides for documentation). If initial analytical results for TPH & BTEX are under RRAL's (site ranking is 0) a Final Report, C-141 will be submitted to the OCD requesting closure. If the analytical results are above the RRAL's a work plan will be submitted to the OCD. **Depth to Ground Water: >100' (approximately 150', Section 1, T22S-R31E, per Trend Map), Wellhead Protection Area: No, Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000', SITE RANKING IS 0.**
