All,

Yesterday evening (6/14/15) we had lightning strike a water storage tank on the above location. The battery consists of 1 water tank and 2 oil tanks. The oil tanks were isolated from the water tank and were not affected. No fire was evident, but the tank was blown up and over the containment wall.

Approximately 105 bbls of produced water were released and 5 recovered. The release affected an area on the pad 300' x 150', and approximately 100' x 30' into the pasture area.

We will have Talon assess the release and develop a workplan. C-141 will follow ASAP.
