The commingled oil and gas production shall be measured and sold at the Rigel "20" Federal Com. Well No. 3H Central Tank Battery (CTB) located in Unit L, Section 20, Township 19 South, Range 31 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.


The oil and gas production from each well shall be separately metered before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C(2) NMAC.

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The operator shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.
