Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*  
Rock Water Energy was in the process of transferring treated water from the Hackberry 16 SWD 1 to the Strawberry 7 Fed Com 11H frac location when the lay flat transfer line came apart causing approximately 150 barrels of treated water to release in the pasture. Approximately 70 barrels were recovered using a polyline to reach the spill area. The area was approximately 895 feet x 100 feet varied, laying along the 2-track.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*  
A temporary polyline was placed along the 2-track with one end at the spill and the other connected to a vacuum truck approximately 200 feet away from the spill. The vacuum truck was able to recover 70 barrels of treated water. Talon was commissioned to inspect the spill area and submit a remediation plan for approval.
