

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*  
A hole had developed in a steel line going from the circulating pump to the heater treater. The steel line has been replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*  
Initially 15 bbls of oil were released from a steel line that had developed a hole going from the circulating pump to the heater treater. 14 bbls were recovered with a vacuum truck. The release was contained within the inside of the facility walls. Tetra Tech inspected site and collected samples to define spills extent. Soil that exceeded RRAL was removed and hauled away for proper disposal. Site was then brought up to surface grade with clean backfill material. Tetra Tech prepared closure report and submitted to NMOCD for review.
