
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

High winds moved a support bracing a PVC water leg causing the leg to break. The PVC leg was replaced with a steel leg.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Tetra Tech inspected site and collected samples to define spills extent. Soil with elevated chloride concentrations was removed and hauled away for proper disposal. A liner was installed. Site was then brought up to surface grade with clean backfill material. Tetra Tech prepared closure report and submitted to NMOCD for review.
