Pursuant to your application received March 18, 2015, WPX Energy Production, LLC (OGRID 120782) is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from the following pools located in Township 23 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County;

Nageezi Gallup	(47540)
Basin Mancos	(97232)

and from the following diversely owned federal leases and allottee leases in said Section, Township, and Range in San Juan County, New Mexico:

Lease: N/2 of Section 5
Description: Federal Lease NMNM018463 and Indian Allotment Lease No-G-1401-1876

Lease: S/2 of Section 5
Description: Federal Lease NMNM018463 and Indian Allotment Lease No-G-1401-1868

Lease: NE/4 NE/4 of Section 8
Description: Federal Lease NMNM109399

The commingled oil and gas production shall be measured and sold at the Chaco 2308-04L Well No. 284H Central Tank Battery (CTB) located in Unit L, Section 4, Township 23 North, Range 8 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production from each of the diversely-owned leases shall be separately metered using allocation meters. Individual well production on each of the leases shall be determined by monthly well test. Lease production shall be determined using allocation and sales meter volume data. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2).

After initial notification, future wells that will produce from the pools and leases approved by this order may be added to this commingling authority by submittal of a Sundry Notice to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe.

This Order supersedes Administrative Order PLC-415, issued on April 10, 2015.

The operator shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Aztec district office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.
