BOPCO EHS was notified of a release that occurred when the head on the triplex pump cracked. Produced water was released to the pump containment causing the containment to overflow to the well pad.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*  
A vacuum truck was called to the location and was able to recover 190 barrels of the fluid. (186 barrels from the containment and 4 barrels PW from the ground).
