




Mr. Hawkins:

Abstract

On May 24 and June 3 and 11, 1999, Arboles Contract Archaeology (Arboles) completed a cultural resources survey of the proposed well pad and pipeline Atlantic B LS #5B for Amoco Production. The proposed access road is contained within the project survey area. The survey is located near Aztec, San Juan County, New Mexico and is under the jurisdiction of the Bureau of Land Management based on BLM surface and mineral ownership. Approximately 7.6 acres were inspected for cultural resources. John Kershner surveyed the project area for archaeological material.

A single site, LA 127199 was recorded during the survey. The site is recommended as potentially eligible to the National Register of Historic Places and Category II status. There are no other properties eligible to the National Register of Historic Places within the survey area. Archaeological clearance to proceed is recommended for the proposed well pad and pipeline with the stipulation that the northeast well pad construction zone not be utilized.

Introduction

On May 24 and June 3 and 11, 1999, Arboles conducted an archaeological survey for Amoco Production of Farmington, New Mexico. Glen Benfield of G and L Services requested the survey on May 21, 1999 and Kim Stratton administered the project for Amoco Production. John Kershner administered the project for Arboles.

Because of the finite and nonrenewable extent of archaeological remains, the Federal government of the United States has enacted legislation that will conserve and protect these resources. Key legislative enactments consist of the Antiquities Act of 1906 (PL 52-209), the Historic Preservation Act of 1966 (PL 89-655) and as amended (PL 96-515), the National Environmental Act of 1969 (PL 91-852), the 1971 Executive Order No. 11593, the Archaeological and Historical Conservation Act of 1974 (PL 93-291), and the Archaeological Resources and Protection Act of 1979 (PL 96-95). To ensure compliance with federal legislation within specific jurisdictional areas, the Navajo Nations and the states of New

Mexico, Arizona, Colorado and Utah have enacted legislation to protect cultural resources.

Description of Undertaking

The proposed well pad will consist of activities associated with natural gas drilling that includes clearing and leveling the location. The proposed area of effect consists of a 50' construction zone surrounding a 230' x 300' well pad. The pipeline is 92' over an existing pipeline corridor from the proposed well pad buffer zone to a tie-in on an existing bladed road.

Methods

A Class 3 survey of the project area was conducted employing straight line transects spaced 5-8 m apart. The center and corners of the proposed well pad and access road were staked before the area was surveyed. Transects were aligned with a Brunton compass and a corner or center stake and a vegetational or topographic point to ensure complete coverage of the proposed project. The survey area consists of the well pad, construction zone enclosed in a cultural resource buffer zone of 100 feet. The pipeline survey consists of a 50' ROW corridor with a cultural resource buffer zone of 50' walked on either side. All archaeological and relevant environmental data were recorded under the guidelines defined by Cultural Resource Fieldwork and Report Standards and Guidelines published by the USDI Bureau of Land Management - Farmington District in 1994. Archaeological sites were recorded using a Brunton compass and 30m and 3m tapes.

Previously Recorded Sites

Prior to the cultural resources survey of the project area, a records search was conducted at the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Farmington Resource Area office to identify sites that may have been previously recorded within the project area. The ARMS files were also searched for properties eligible to the National Register of Historic Places within the survey area. The records search on May 21,

1999 produced one site within 500 feet of the project buffer zone (see appendix).

Project Environment: The proposed well pad and pipeline are located on a gentle ridge slope above North Fork Arroyo. Soils are deep clay sediments supporting sage, piñon and juniper. Numerous shallow drainages cut through the location.

Recommendations: Archaeological clearance to proceed is recommended for the proposed well pad and pipeline with the stipulation that the northeast well pad construction zone not be utilized.

Cultural resources: A single site, LA 127199 was recorded during the survey. The site is recommended as potentially eligible to the National Register of Historic Places and Category II status. There are no other properties eligible to the National Register of Historic Places within the survey area.

Occasionally in the shallow drainages are small reddish brown sandstone clasts. These clasts do not appear to be oxidized as the reddish brown color is derived from the clay and sandstone ridge above the location. The clast pockets were trowel tested and did not yield burned material or other cultural indicators.





Figure 2: Project

proposed well pad and pipeline Atlantic B LS #5B




PAD LAYOUT PLAN & PROFILE


