


Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*
The West Artesia Grayburg Unit #4, which is an injection well, was being flowed back to a frac tank in preparation for a repair of the well. Sometime between the close of business on 07/20/2010 and the morning of 07/21/2010 the tank overflowed. The tank was drained and the water flow was stopped. Preliminary cleanup was done pending the testing to determine the extent of the damage.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
Water ran across the well pad, down portions of the entrance road to the well and into the adjacent pasture. The pad, pasture, and road will be tested and a formal remediation plan submitted.
