Mike,

Please find the attached C-141 for the Plains Marketing crude oil release which occurred on 4/2/2014. Plains released approximately 14 barrels of crude oil and recovered approximately 10 barrels. The crude oil release was the result of equipment failure, a gasket on a pump cover failed. Basin Environmental will be conducting remediation activities at the site. The impacted material will be excavated and soil samples will be collected. The excavated soil will be transported to an NMOCD approved land farm. Soil samples will be collected from the excavation and submitted to the laboratory for Benzene, BTEX, TPH, and chloride analysis. On laboratory confirmation of benzene, BTEX, TPH, and chloride concentrations less than 10 mg/Kg, 50 mg/Kg, 5,000 mg/Kg, and 1,000 mg/Kg respectively. On your approval, the excavation will be backfilled with locally obtained non-impacted material.
