The commingled and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Aldabra 26-27 Central Tank Battery (CTB), located in Unit P, Section 27, Township 23 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Production from the subject wells shall be determined as follows:

The oil and gas production from each of the diversely-owned leases shall be separately metered using allocation meters.

The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2).

Subsequently drilled wells that produce from the subject pool within the project areas approved by this order may be added to this commingling authority by submittal of a Sundry Notice to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe.

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The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.
