Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. (OGRID 6137) is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from Turkey Track; Bone Spring Pool (pool code 60660) from the following leases and wells in Eddy County, New Mexico:

Lease: State Lease VB-2153
Description: W/2 of Section 13, Township 19 South, Range 29 East, NMPM
Well: Peridot "13" State Well No. 1H
Peridot "13" State Well No. 2H
Peridot "13" State Well No. 5H
Peridot "13" State Well No. 6H

Lease: State Lease VB-2141
Description: W/2 E/2 of Section 13, Township 19 South, Range 29 East, NMPM
Well: Peridot "13" State Well No. 3H
Peridot "13" State Well No. 7H

The combined project area for these wells include the W/2 E/2 and W/2 of Section 13, Township 19 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Peridot "13" State Well No. 1H Central Tank Battery (CTB), located in Unit K, Section 12, Township 19 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Production from the subject wells shall be determined as follows:

The oil and gas production from the identically-owned leases shall be separately metered using a combination of well testing and metering. Further, this is an existing surface commingling facility, and this application is for records clean-up.

The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2).

Subsequently drilled wells that produce from the subject pool within the project areas approved by this order may be added to this commingling authority by submittal of a Sundry Notice to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe.

The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.
