BOPCO had an accidental release of produced water at the JRU 10 tank battery. The water transfer pump failed and the tank overflowed into the earthen containment. Fluids remained within the containment with exception of the sw corner, though what little escaped remained on the well pad, and 40 bbls pw was recovered.
