Legacy Reserves Operating, LP (OGRID 240974) is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from Anderson; Wolfcamp, North Pool (pool code 97183) from the following leases and wells in Eddy County, New Mexico:

Lease: Federal Lease CA NM126360
Description: N/2 N/2 of Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 28 East, NMPM
Well: Blitzen "35" Federal Com. Well No. 1H

Lease: Federal Lease CA NM124318
Description: S/2 N/2 of Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 28 East, NMPM
Well: Blitzen "35" Federal Com. Well No. 2H

The combined project area for these wells include the N/2 of Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The commingled and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Blitzen "35" Federal Com. Central Tank Battery (CTB), located in Unit H, Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Production from the subject wells shall be determined as follows:


The oil and gas production from the leases shall be metered using a combination of well testing and metering. Further, this is an existing surface commingling facility, and this application is for records clean-up.

The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2).

Subsequently drilled wells that produce from the subject pool within the project areas approved by this order may be added to this commingling authority by submittal of a Sundry Notice to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe.

The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.
