RE: Injection Pressure Increase East Millman Unit Waterflood Project Eddy County, New Mexico

Dear Mr. Arguijo:

Reference is made to your request received by the Division on March 14, 2006, to increase the surface injection pressure on three wells within the East Millman Unit Waterflood Project. This request is based on step rate test data and fracture treatment data from the subject wells. The results of this data shows that an increase in the surface injection pressure for these wells is justified and will not result in the fracturing of the injection formation and confining strata.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following wells located in Township 19 South, Range 28 East, NMPM:

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The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected fluid is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
