Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*  This blowdown was in response to a leak on this pipeline that occurred on 12/23/2015 where the leak was clamped. In this instance, the damaged section of pipe was replaced with new requiring that the pipeline be blown down again. A PIG was ran on the pipeline before the blowdown to avoid any liquid release; therefore, there were no soil impacts from this event.
