

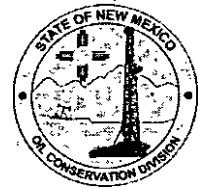

Matador Production Company (OGRID 228937) is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from Forehand Ranch; Wolfcamp (Gas) Pool (pool code 76780) from the following diversely owned Fee leases and wells in Eddy County, New Mexico:

Lease: Dr. K 24 23S 27E RB Well No. 206H
Description: N/2 Section 24, Township 23 South, Range 27 East, NMPM
Well: Dr. K 24 23S 27E RB Well No. 206H

Lease: Dr. K 24 23S 27E RB Well No. 203H
Description: S/2 Section 24, Township 23 South, Range 27 East, NMPM
Well: Dr. K 24 23S 27E RB Well No. 203H

The combined project area for these wells include the entire Section 24, Township 23 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Dr. K Central Tank Battery (CTB), located in Unit M, Section 24, Township 23 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Production from the subject wells shall be determined as follows:


The oil and gas production from each of the diversely-owned leases shall be separately metered using allocation meters.

The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2).

Subsequently drilled wells that produce from the subject pool within the project areas approved by this order may be added to this commingling authority by submittal of a Sundry Notice to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe.

The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.
