This is a historical release that occurred due to a failing valve or connection on a 6" PVC line prior to the pipeline being taken out of service.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

An approximate area of 30' X 20' was affected around the tin horn. Vertical and horizontal delineation samples will be taken and analysis ran for TPH & BTEX (chlorides for documentation). If initial analytical results for TPH & BTEX are under RRAL's (site ranking is 0) a Final Report, C-141 will be submitted to the OCD requesting closure. If the analytical results are above the RRAL a work plan will be submitted to the OCD. Depth to Ground Water: >100' (approximately 275', Section 12, T19S-R24E, per Trend Map), Wellhead Protection Area: No, Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000', SITE RANKING IS 0.
