Dear Mr. Stone:

Reference is made to your request on behalf of OWL SWD Operating, LLC ("operator") to extend the February 25, 2016 deadline stipulated in order SWD-1536 to commence drilling operations for the above referenced well for an additional six months for reasons outlined in the attached correspondence. The first extension was issued January 22, 2016, and extended the deadline to August 25, 2016.

Paragraph nine of the administrative order contains a condition of approval that stipulates a deadline to spud the referenced well. This condition is the result of an agreement between the operator and the potash company with mineral interests at the well's location.


As required in the order, the Division has been provided confirmation by the Mosaic Potash Company that it has no objections to another six-month extension of the order for the referenced well.

Additionally, it is the Division's understanding from your request that there have been no significant changes in the information provided in the application submitted for review and approval of this order.

The Division finds that granting this request to extend this administrative order is in the interest of conservation, will prevent waste, and will protect the environment.

All requirements of the above referenced administrative order and agreements in the application remain in full force and effect excepting the deadline in which to commence drilling operations shall be extended to February 25, 2017. The deadline to commence injection operations remains May 19, 2017.

Owl SWD Operating, LLC has recently requested and received approval from Mosaic Potash Company to extend the above referenced deadline to spud the subject well for an additional six month period. The request was made to Mr. Dan Morehouse, Mine Superintendent for Mosaic in Carlsbad, New Mexico.

In the request, I explained that in addition to the struggles of dealing with the slowdown in the industry, some of Owl's projects have come in much higher than AFE estimates with one being almost double of expected expenditures and that there have been no changes in the subject area of review.
