Corrosion of a nipple on the water transfer line caused a 238 bbls leak of produced water. A vacuum truck recovered 120 bbls and the nipple was replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

The affected area is approximately 100' x 50' with most of the leak staying on location. Remediation will be completed in accordance with an approved remediation plan from NMOCD and the BLM.

This is to inform you that Oxy Permian had a release at the Sundance Federal A CTB on August 9, 2016. Oxy released 0.25 bbl of oil and 50 bbls of produced water due to excess water being pumped in and alarm failure. The preliminary report indicates the leak is approximately 90' x 70' within the berm behind the water tanks. Recovery efforts are in progress. The release is located in Section 4, T24S, R31E in Eddy County, NM. Driving directions: From Carlsbad, go East on US 285, turn North on NM31, turn East on NM128, go to MM14, turn South on Pure Gold Rd, cross 3 CGs and go 2.75 miles to location on East side of road.
