The California E pipeline developed a hydrostatic obstruction and had to be blown down to allow the hydrate to dissolve and move in the pipeline thereby removing the restriction. Four miles of the pipeline was blown down a two (2) locations in Eddy County for a total of 2,932 Mscf.

None this was a gas only release.
