Pipeline liquids were released into a salt waterbody on the Tamarisk Flat. The salt waterbody is a fully enclosed natural depression with no outlet to navigable waters.



Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Natural gas and pipeline liquids were released due to a pipeline leak. The pipeline segment was isolated, blown down, and repaired following a standard one-call. Approximately 35 bbls of liquid were noted on the ROW.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

A liquid spill of approximately 35 bbls occurred as part of the leak. Remediation actions will follow the Enterprise Products, General Release Notification, Response and Remediation Plan (March 9, 2015).
