Chevron U.S.A. Inc. ("Chevron") (OGRID 4323) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **SD WE 15 Fed P9 No. 6H Well** (API No. 30-025-43461) to be completed within the Bone Spring (Jennings; Upper Bone Spring Shale (97838)) underlying the W/2 E/2 of Section 15. This well will be drilled from a surface location 12 feet from the South line and 1,446 feet from the East line (Unit O). The first perforation will be located 330 feet from the South line, 1,342 feet from the East line (Unit O) and the final perforation will be located 330 feet from the North line and 1,342 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section15. Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules which provide for wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit, the completed interval for this well will be unorthodox because it is closer than 330 feet to the eastern, southeastern, and northeastern boundaries of the project area.

Chevron is the 100% working interest owner in Section 15. Ownership in the spacing and proration unit in the E/2 E/2 is therefore common with the proposed spacing unit and therefore there are no affected parties in the spacing units to the East. Chevron will operate the SD WE 15 Fed P9 No. 7H Well (API No. 30-025-43462) in the E/2 E/2. Approval of the unorthodox completed interval will allow Chevron to develop these sections using their preferred well spacing plan for horizontal wells in this area, and thereby prevent waste of a productive reservoir.

Exhibit A is the Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102), which shows that the completed interval of the proposed **SD WE 15 Fed P9 No. 6H Well** encroaches on the spacing and proration units to the East, Northeast, and Southeast.




