You have requested to drill this well at a non-standard gas spacing unit described above in the referenced pool or formation. This gas spacing unit is governed by the Special Rules for the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp (Gas) Pool, which provides for 320-acre units, with wells located at least 330 feet from a unit outer boundary. The applicant is requesting that the SE/4 of Section 24 be excluded from the project area.
